CAVE SPELUNKING DAY TRIP

Prepare to get “down and dirty” in some of the local caves that began as natural holes in bedrock, formed by ancient groundwater and glacial meltwater. After breakfast at Camp, we’ll head to Ledgeview Nature Center in Chilton, WI, where we will meet a Park Naturalist who will take us on our journey down below the surface. As we crawl 60 ft. underground, we will navigate around cave obstacles as well as learn how these natural phenomena were formed. Upon our resurface to the ground above, we will surely be caked in cave mud, a great exfoliant for the skin! We’ll return to Camp in time for lunch and the rest of the day’s activities.
